Hope this newsletter finds you well and enjoying early spring!

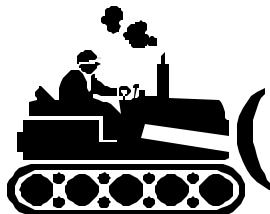

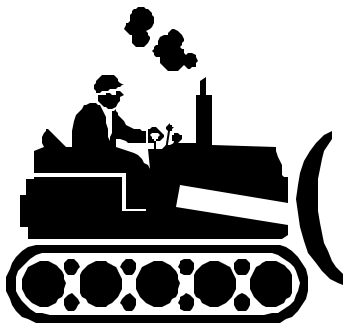
