The city council and city manager are behind us 100% and want to help make this work for us. We have a verbal agreement at this time with a private land owner who owns ten acres that joins the proposed city property. This gentleman says that if our club secures a lease with the City of Haskell for the use of their land

that he will allow us to use his ten acres of property that joins the city land. This is a big commitment to our club from a private land owner.

The proposed new club grounds are located one half mile north of Haskell on state highway 72. The property is on the east side of the highway between the airport and the cemetery right on highway 72. The property is approximately twelve miles south of our old location. This location offers our club great visibility to the public and we won't be prohibited from advertising our events with signs on the highway like we were at Coweta.
