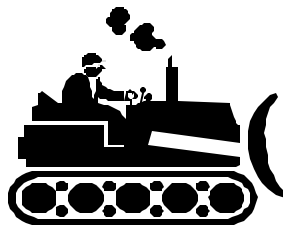
bring desserts and/or other foods to go along with beans, chili, and taco soup.

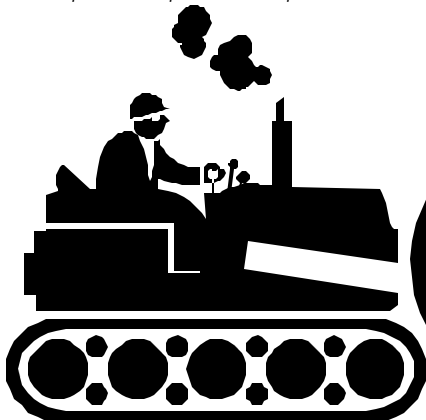

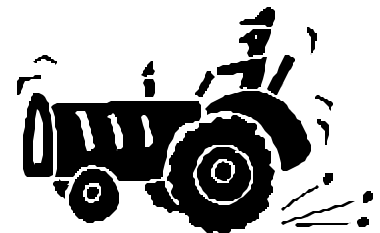
